

Tin Can Bird Feeders

Supplies

- Tin can
- Newspaper
- Popsicle stick
- String (about 24inches)
- Hot glue gun
- Acrylic paint
- Foam paint brush
- Metal punch or utility knife
- Bird Seed



- 1) Paint your can! I like to use outdoor acrylic paint. Spray paint could work as well.
- 2) Punch holes in each end of the can for your string. This is not a job for little hands-I highly recommend that an adult helps with this. I used my utility tool, but a metal punch would work as well.
- 3) Attach your string. I like running it through the can and tying it outside to the branch.



4) Using hot glue stick on the popsicle stick

5) Find a place to hang it up, put some birdseed in and wait for your feathered friends to arrive!
